Appendix B

CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR PRESENTATION OF MATERIALS

Reports (Kazakh, Russian, English optional) are submitted **until September 1, 2025** in the form of an electronic copy in MSWord format, via e-mail with an attached file.

By submitting an application, the conference participant agrees to the processing of his personal data by the conference organizing committee.

Materials presented by conference participants are checked for borrowings, as well as editorial selection for the correctness of scientific content, compliance with the conference topic and technical requirements. The originality of the text must be at least 70%.

Materials that do not pass the editorial selection are not published or reviewed.

Materials sent after the deadline will not be considered.

Participant certificates will be sent electronically by **November 3, 2025** to the email addresses provided by participants in the applications.

An ELECTRONIC COLLECTION OF CONFERENCE MATERIALS will be sent to participants and posted on the university website **until November 3, 2025**.

The volume of the article is **no less than 3 and no more than 6 pages** in A4 format, including drawings.

At the beginning, in the direction of the article, the universal decimal classification (UDC) index code is indicated in the upper left corner.

After 1 interval, the title of the article is formed in the center in capital letters.

The title of the article is printed in capital letters, centered on the line, in bold.

The initials and surnames of the authors (in bold) are printed at 2 intervals, indicating the name of the organization, city and country.

Below, the text is printed at 2 intervals.

The font of the article text is 11 point Times New Roman.

Line spacing is single.

Page parameters – 20 mm on all sides.

The list of information sources used in preparing the article is located at the end of the article through a line (Enter), no more than 10 sources (10 pt).

The sources are listed in the order of references to them in the article. The reference number in the text of the article is written in square brackets, for example – [1]. The list of references is drawn up in accordance with GOST 7.5-98 “System of standards for information, library and publishing. Magazines, collections, information publications. Publishing design of published materials.”

Design of tables. Each table must be numbered and have a title. The table number and title are placed above the table in the upper left edge. The table name is placed with a dash (for example: Table 1 -).

Design of graphic materials. Graphic materials must be prepared using Microsoft Graph or Excel. Graphic objects must be grouped. Graphic objects should not extend beyond the page margins and exceed one page.

Each object must be numbered and have a caption and be located in the center.

Design of formulas. Mathematical formulas are created using the formula editor of Microsoft Equation. Their numbering is indicated on the right side in parentheses. If there are a large number of formulas, it is recommended to number independently for each section.

The file name must begin with the last name of the first author of the article.

A conference participant can be the author or co-author of no more than 3 articles.

There is no registration fee for participation in the conference. Publication of an article in a collection of materials is free.

The best publications will be recommended for publication in the Bulletin of Karaganda University named after Ye.A. Buketov
